"What message does my Lord have for His [people]?"

Joshua 5:14

Since spring is a time for fresh starts, what Scriptures did God give us to help us along that way? From a recent message we preached at North Kannapolis Baptist Church, here are a few ideas. Will it help me spiritually? 6). 1 Corinthians 14:40. Would it cause confusion? 7). 1 Corinthians 16:14. Is it a loving thing to do? 8). 2 Corinthians 6:3, 4. Would it hurt my service for Christ? 9). Philippians 2:14. Can I be positive about it? 10). Colossians 3:17. Can I do it for the Lord? 11). Colossians 3:20. Would people I respect say it is right? 12). 1 Thessalonians 4:13-17. Do I want to be doing it when Jesus comes? 13). 1 Thessalonians 5:17. Have I prayed about it? 14). 1 Thessalonians 5:18. Can I thank God for it? 15). 1 Thessalonians 5:21. Is it of lasting value? 16). 1 Timothy 6:17. Will I look back on this with joy? 17). 2 Timothy 4:5. Is it "of God"? 18). Titus 2:7. Is it good for others? 19). Titus 2:10-13. Does the Bible say it is right (do I want to be doing this or thinking this when Jesus comes again)? 20). Hebrews 12:1. Is it a weight? 21). Hebrews 13:18. Would I have to lie to cover it up? 22). 1 Peter 2:17. Can I respect others who do it? 23).1 Peter 3:15. Does it impact my testimony for Christ?

# **Alaska Mission Trip**

Matthew's Gospel in 28:19 details Jesus commanding His followers, "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit" (New King James Version).

Since 2008, Thirst Missions has led over 800 teams and 15,000 people on mission trips. They offer over 14 ministry options which include construction, church ministry, prayer walking, outreach ministry, evangelism, and youth ministry.

Dion Short will lead a mission trip to Alaska consisting of 6 days/5 nights in late summer or early fall. The team will fly out of Charlotte (details later). The location is Anchorage, Alaska, in the Matanuska Valley. This location offers a diverse population with many mission/ministry opportunities.

The cost, after a registration fee of \$499, will be \$799 per person. The initial plan is for a team of 4. Please prayerfully consider your involvement.
